Difficulty hearing in any situation, routine screening for patients over 50 years old, family history of hearing loss, trauma/injury to the ear, congenital syndromes (autism, Down syndrome)	Hearing test	Standard comprehensive assessment includes:  Pure tone audiometry Speech audiometry Middle ear assessment Recommendations for next steps Implementation of clinical management, including where appropriate, a hearing aid trial (please advise if medical contraindications)	
Sudden hearing loss in one or both ears	Hearing test immediately and ABR	If required, urgent ENT assessment should be arranged with your permission	
Known hearing loss affecting communication and daily activities	Hearing test and hearing aid evaluation (HAE)	Includes comprehensive assessment and an unbiased professional hearing aid recommendation	
Repeated ear infection	Hearing test	Determines if there is any fluid in the middle ear. If fluid found, an ENTassessment should be arranged with your permission.	
Children with speech delay or if newborn screening was missed	Hearing test	Soundfield / VRA Play audiometry	
Learning difficulties	Central auditory processing assessment (CAP)	Comprehensive assessment of hearing, middle ear analysis, and auditory processing. Detailed recommendations provided for the family and teachers.	
Tinnitus (ringing in the ears) Assessment	Tinnitus assessment includes:  Hearing test Pitch/loudness match ABR and VEMP to rule out retrocochlear pathology Otoacoustic emissions (OAE)	Determines whether medical intervention or tinnitus treatment is required. The provision of information and coping strategies is usually enough to alleviate concern or the need to progress to treatment.

Dizziness, vertigo or disequilibrium, post-concussion assessment	Hearing test + Balance testing (VNG/VAT/VEMP/vHIT)	Comprehensive hearing test and balance assessment to determine site of lesion and to make recommendations for further medical management or rehabilitation.

Recurrent dizziness with imbalance and normal vestibular functions	Computerized Dynamic Posturography (CDP)	Assess functional aspects of disability and help in planning management (VRT)	
Suspicion of malingering/long term insurance claims with indescribable dizziness and balance disorder	Computerized Dynamic Posturography (CDP)	One of the most important tests to determine malingering.	
Chronic dizziness related to vestibular disorders	Vestibular Rehabilitation Therapy (VRT)	Assessment of extent of disorder, functional assessment (CDP) and rehab
